FIRST READING: Genesis 2:18-24

We hear of second biblical narrative of the creation stories from Genesis. The Lord God is portrayed as completing the work of creation by forming woman to complete the human from the humus to become one body and one flesh.

Response: Psalm 127

May the Lord bless us all the days of our lives.

SECOND READING: Hebrews 2:9-11

We begin a series of seven readings from the letter to the Hebrews. The author details Jesus' acceptance of being humbled even to death on the cross, but was raised by God's grace. Human like us, Jesus leads the Paschal Mystery by which we too are to be raised up in his Spirit.

Gospel Acclamation: Sung Alleluia

GOSPEL READING: Mark 10:2-16

The famous dialogue in which the Pharisees approached Jesus to ask what was the law about divorce. Jesus draws attention to the original Genesis creation story which is the basis of his emphasis that "...what God has united, no one must divide".

Vision: Capricorn Coast Parish will be a community of believers, where all who come will find God's love in action, in us and through us and have their own personal experience with the Risen Christ.
