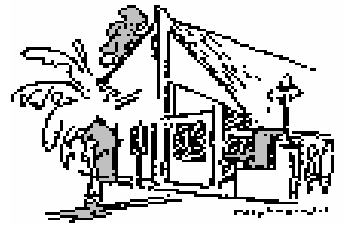

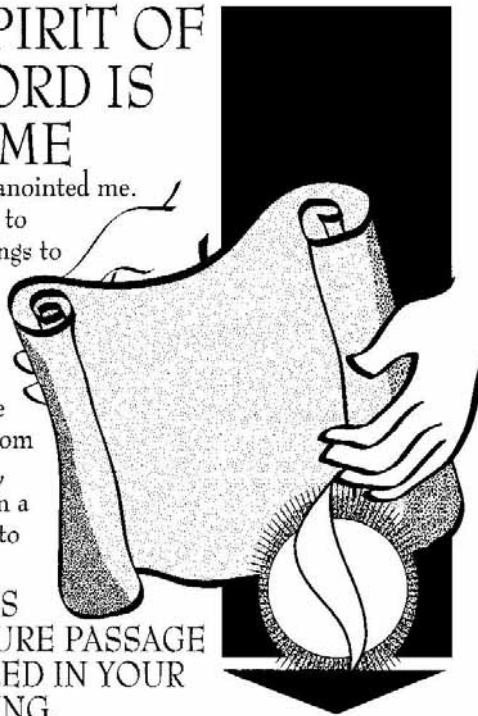
Follow me, says the Lord, and you will have the light of life!

FIRST READING: Nehemiah 8:2-6. 8-10

We hear the powerful witness in an assemble of the people. They listen attentively as Ezra reads and explains God's Word from the Book of the Law—the very thing we are doing now.

Response: Psalm 18

Your words, Lord, are spirit and life.

SECOND READING: 1 Corinthians 12:12-30

We hear St Paul's most famous metaphor to describe the unity of the assembly, which is the Church. In communion with Christ and with one another they make up the Body of Christ but each is a different part of it.

Gospel Acclamation: Sung Alleluia

GOSEL READING: Luke 1:1-4, 4:14-21

We hear the beginning of Luke's Gospel with a summary of his purpose and why he wrote it. We then hear how Jesus himself fulfilled the text of the prophecy as they listen to him read in his home town.

Vision: Capricorn Coast Parish will be a community of believers, where all who come will find God's love in action, in us and through us and have their own personal experience with the Risen Christ.

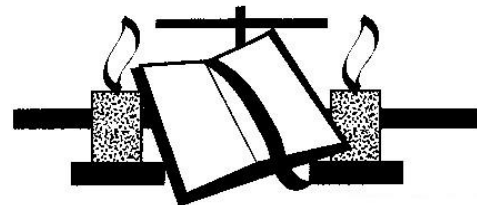
