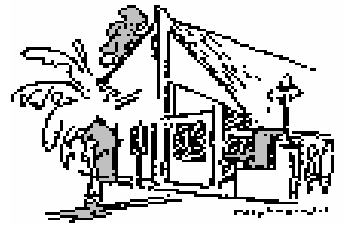

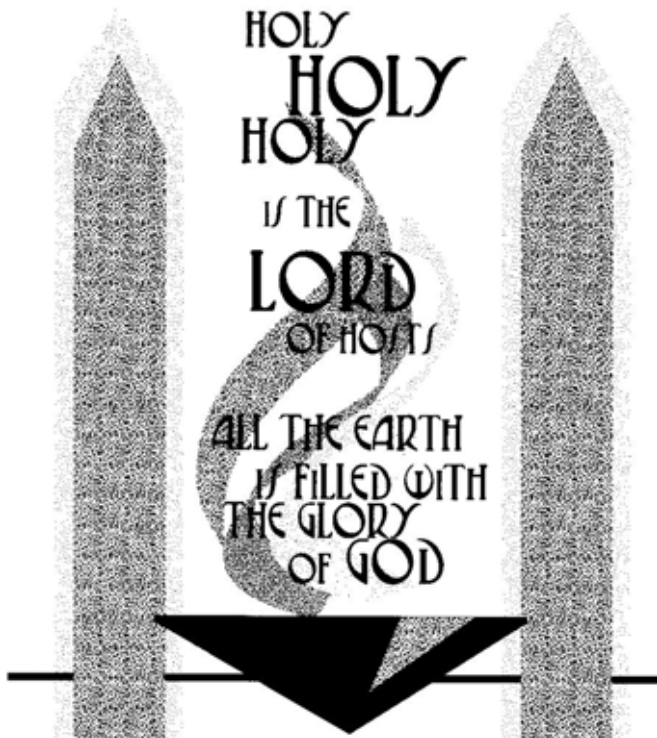

With you Lord, no tear is unheeded!

Introduction: The call from God is a common expression both in Scriptures themselves and in Christian circles of believers. Our readings today give us several different examples in which those people make their personal response to God's call. Are we ready to listen?



FIRST READING: Isaiah 6:1-8

We hear the prophet Isaiah more than any other Old Testament figure. Today we hear his sense of being unworthy and still he responded. People may also recognise the source of our *Holy, holy, holy* prayer in the Mass at the Eucharistic Prayer.

Response: Psalm 137

In the sight of the angels I will sing your praises, Lord.

SECOND READING: 1 Corinthians 15:1-11

We hear how St Paul acknowledges how he moved beyond the tradition in which he was first formed to open himself to the responsibility of being an apostle. Are we ready to reflect on our journey and our response?

Gospel Acclamation: Sung Alleluia

GOSPEL READING: Luke 5:1-11

We hear how Jesus called his disciples in the midst of their every day activities and jobs. Initially reluctant, Simon Peter can change his attitude and seek to respond. Can we say the same?

Vision: Capricorn Coast Parish will be a community of believers, where all who come will find God's love in action, in us and through us and have their own personal experience with the Risen Christ.
