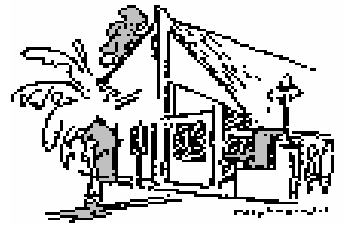

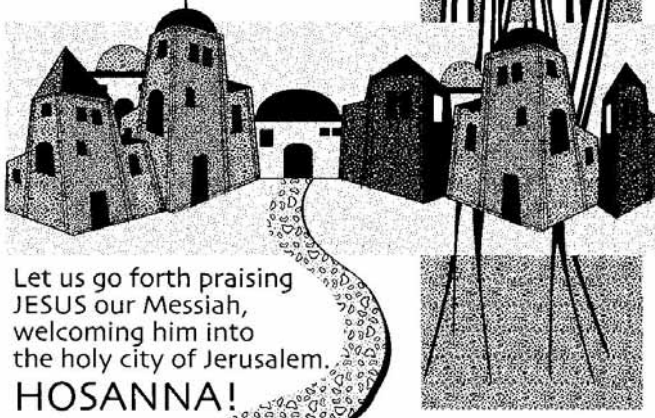
Passion (Palm) Sunday Year C

PROCESSION GOSPEL: Luke 19:28-40

We hear the events in Jerusalem on the original Palm Sunday. This day and at every Mass we take up the chant: "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!"

Response: Psalm 22

My god, my God, why have you abandoned me?

FIRST READING: Isaiah 50:4-7

We hear the words of Isaiah about the Suffering Servant of Yahweh, fulfilled in Jesus.

SECOND READING: Philippians 2:6-11

We hear a hymn from the early Church that St Paul quotes to emphasise the humility of Jesus in becoming human like us.

Gospel Acclamation:

Glory and praise to you Lord Jesus Christ
Glory and praise to you.

PASSION READING: Luke 22:14-23:56

We hear St Luke's particular style of eye witness accounts of the events in the passion of Jesus.

Vision: Capricorn Coast Parish will be a community of believers, where all who come will find God's love in action, in us and through us and have their own personal experience with the Risen Christ.

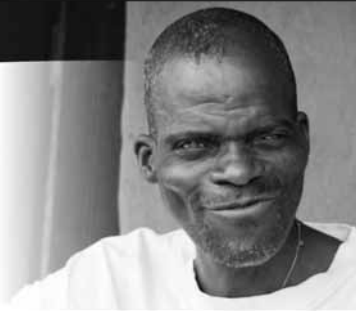
