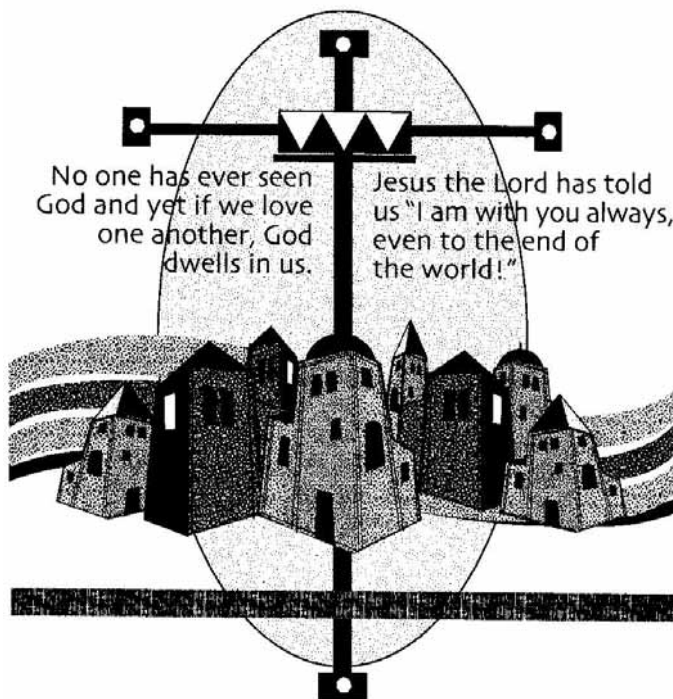

The Ascension of the Lord Year C

May 16 2010

May we follow Christ with love!

Introduction: Welcome to our parish for this celebration of the Ascension of the Lord to heaven. To celebrate Ascension on a Sunday is the Church's encouragement to emphasise the place of the Ascension in the Paschal Mystery which is the realisation of Christ's redemption of the world being available to us now.



FIRST READING: Acts of the Apostles 1:1-11

We hear the beginning of St Luke's preface to the Acts of the Apostles. He connects his Gospel with the mission of the Church in the power of the Holy Spirit after Christ's Ascension to heaven.

Response: Psalm 47

God mounts his throne to shouts of joy: a blare of trumpets for the Lord.

SECOND READING: Ephesians 1:17-23

We hear a reflection of St Paul about the completion of Jesus' mission in the world. He draws attention to the power at work in Christ which is now animating the Church, which is his Body.

Gospel Acclamation:

Sung Alleluia

GOSPEL READING: Luke 24:46-53

We hear the end of the Gospel of Luke when Jesus encouraged the disciples that they were to be his witnesses beginning from Jerusalem, when the Spirit he promised would come down on them at Pentecost.

Vision: Capricorn Coast Parish will be a community of believers, where all who come will find God's love in action, in us and through us and have their own personal experience with the Risen Christ.
