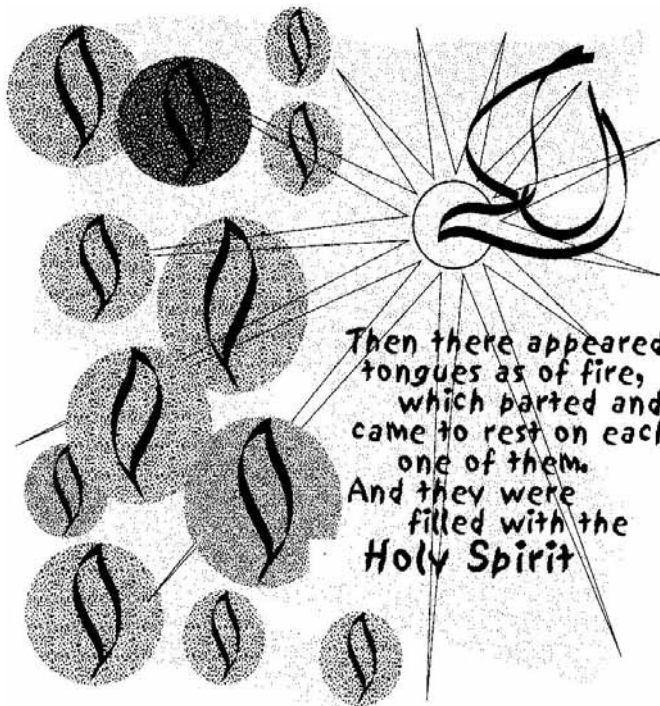

Introduction: Welcome to our celebration of the birthday of the Church. This day we rejoice that Christ filled the Church with the power of the Spirit he promised and now we are all empowered to give witness to the world.



FIRST READING: Acts of the Apostles 2:1-11

We hear the stirring events of the first Pentecost. St Luke shapes these images to resonate with the creation story in Genesis. Now is the age of the new creation in the Holy Spirit.

Response: Psalm 104

Lord, send out your Spirit and renew the face of the earth.

SECOND READING: Romans 8:8-17

We hear a segment of St Paul after he has written about Baptism. In this passage he emphasizes "...the Spirit of God has made his home in you". "The Spirit himself and our spirit bear united witness that we are the children of God".

GOSPEL READING: John 14:15-16. 23-26

We hear more of John's account of the Last Supper and the promise of Jesus to ask his Father to send "... another Advocate ..., the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in my name".


