We begin a series of readings from the letter to the Galatians. We are children of God through faith in Christ, Jesus the Lord, because of our baptism. We are all now united in Christ.

GOSPEL READING: Luke 9:18-24

At the conclusion of the ministry of Jesus in Galilee, we hear Luke's version of Peter's confession of faith, which differs from the words in Matthew's Gospel. This is the pivotal point in Luke's gospel: Jesus sets his face towards Jerusalem and all that will follow.

Mary MacKillop—An Australian Like Us

Born in Melbourne on January 15 1842, of Scottish migrant
parents, Mary was the eldest of eight children. Her mother,
Flora (McDonald), a strong and courageous woman, had
amazing trust in God's Providence. Her 'schoolmaster'
father, Alexander, was unsuccessful in business. In 1873,
Mary wrote: "My life as a child was one of sorrow, my home
when I had it a most unhappy one... When I was a little more
than sixteen years of age, the principal care of a large family
fell upon me, and ... I felt its burden yearly more and more."

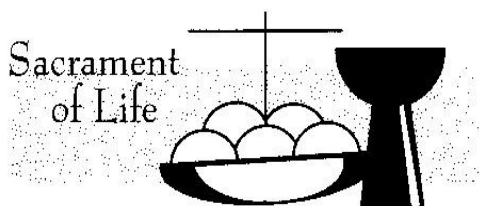
