Christ has scattered the darkness of sin!

Introduction: When we read continuously from a specific Gospel, it helps to know there is a pattern in St Luke, the Gospel of this Season. Week by week, we hear a central piece of the Travel Narrative. Luke follows the choices of Jesus as he forms his disciples and us, then and now.

FIRST READING: 1 Kings 19:16. 19-21

We hear a rather odd story that is meant to connect with the Gospel. Just as Jesus prepared his disciples for the journey to Jerusalem, so too the Lord prepared Elijah for what he had to do to fulfil God's plan. Are we prepared to respond to God's call to us?

Response: Psalm 16

You are my inheritance, O Lord.

SECOND READING: Galatians 5:1. 13-18

St Paul addresses the people in Galatia in what could be the oldest New Testament writings, encouraging them to remember the goodwill as they first followed Christ.

Gospel Acclamation:

Sung Alleluia

GOspel READING: Luke 9:51-62

We hear about the planning of St Luke's Gospel. He uses strong Old Testament resonances with the important decision Jesus takes to head for Jerusalem as his Father's plan unfolds.

Mary MacKillop—An Australian Like Us

Mary's father, Alexander, was often caught up in speculative ventures but his lack of business sense, combined with passionate idealism (including forays into politics), led to temporary periods of slight prosperity but ended in insolvency. Unable to support his wife and children, a dispirited Alexander moved away. With compassionate love for him, Mary wrote to her mother in 1867: "I do feel for his lonely state." In 1868, with his loving wife Flora at his side, Alexander died in Hamilton, Victoria.
