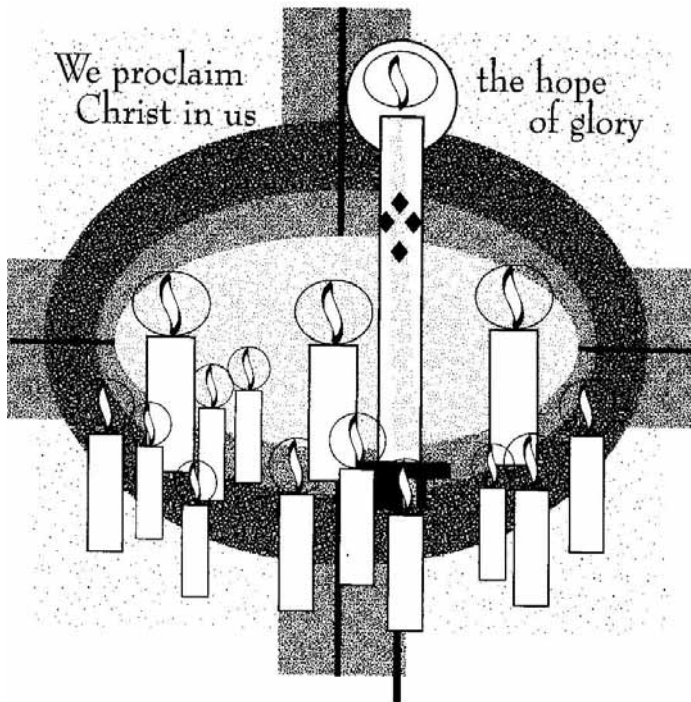

Mary MacKillop—An Australian Like Us

In 1862, Mary MacKillop returned to Melbourne but soon moved to Portland where she educated a family's young children, then taught in the Denominational School. As church sacristan, she had 'charge of the Altar and the Lamp' and was 'able to go into the chapel at any time, where the Blessed Sacrament always is.' Mary regarded this as 'a precious favour indeed' even when she was mistakenly locked in for a night. (1864)

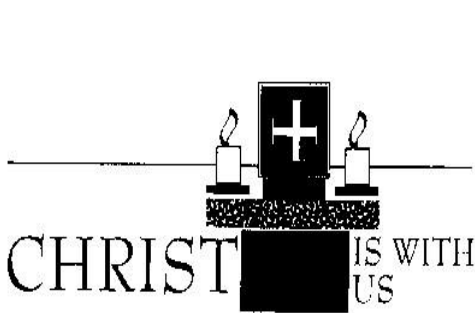

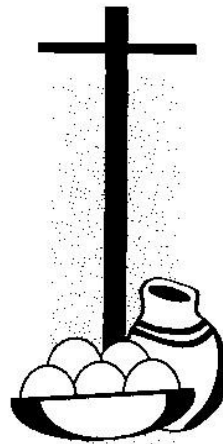
