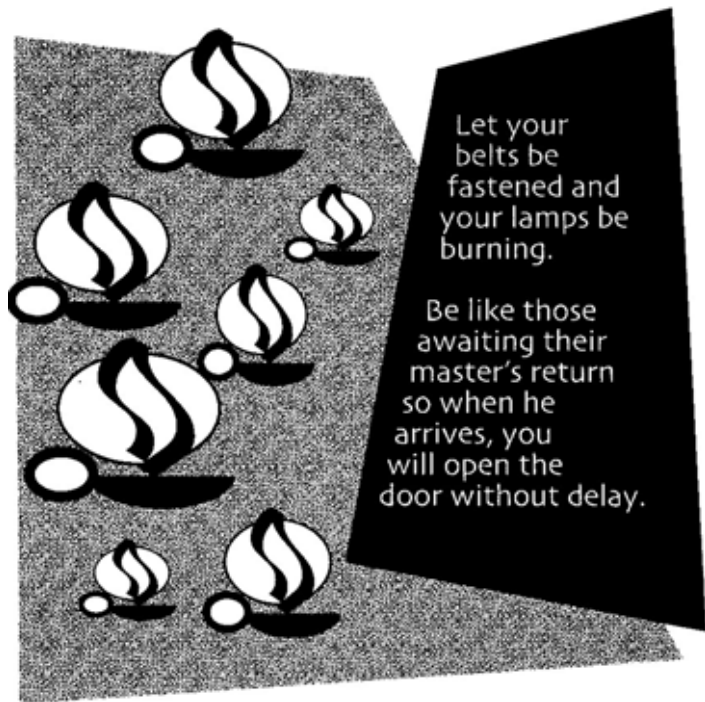

### Make us signs of love to all the world!

**Introduction:** Today is the attributed Feast Day of Mary MacKillop, Australia's prospective saint. Today we suffer somewhat from a particular liturgical dilemma. This is because a Sunday does not allow for the Mass texts to be substituted for the prayers of the particular memorial of the Saint of the Day. Even so, it doesn't mean we cannot bring Mary MacKillop into our prayers and reflections this day.



Let your belts be fastened and your lamps be burning.

Be like those awaiting their master's return so when he arrives, you will open the door without delay.

**FIRST READING:** Wisdom 18:6-9

This passage reflects on the exodus and the liberation from Egypt. The same events brought both salvation to the Jews but destruction to their enemies.

**Response:** Psalm 33

Happy the people the Lord has chosen to be his own

**SECOND READING:** Hebrews 11:1-2. 8-19

We hear a passage which is one of the clearest descriptions of faith in the scriptures. It shows faith is a response to God's plan, accepting the belief in God and how our decisions in life are determined by faith, and Abraham serves a model to illustrate this.

**Gospel Acclamation:**

**GOSPEL READING:** Luke 12:32-48

We hear how Jesus shows his disciples how faith and confidence in him should direct their lives. For all of us, there is no need for fear or anxiety if we trust God's plan.

**Mary MacKillop — An Australian Like Us**  
Mary MacKillop wrote to her mother, "When I was (Lexie's) age (15) I began first to long for a Religious Life." (1866) It is presumed that she would have intended entry into the Melbourne Sisters of Mercy. In Penola, however, she saw the need for a new kind of Religious Congregation: one whose members could live in isolated places, be free to move where needed, and go where other nuns could not.
