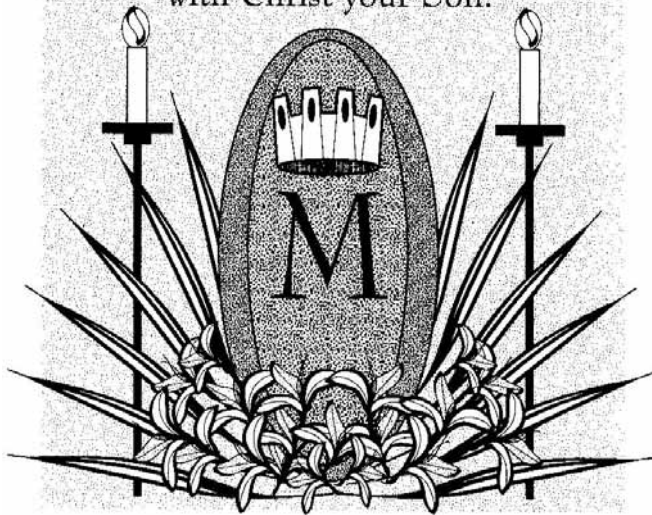
Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Introduction: Two of the major Feasts of Our Lady are very strongly connected in the life of the Church. The Feast of the Immaculate Conception of the Virgin Mary, December 8, links with today's Feast of the Assumption of Mary into heaven. In short, it could be said that in her Immaculate Conception, Mary anticipates the fruits of Baptism, by having from the first moment of her human existence, the full sharing in divine life on earth and in heaven. Mary's wonderful favour reminds us of the life of grace we all share with Christ in Baptism, and in our Eucharist today.

Fr Woods encouraged Mary MacKillop's Religious vocation and, when two ladies of similar mind joined her, he submitted to the Bishop his plan for the Rule. As Director General of the diocesan schools, he invited Mary and her Sisters to Adelaide in June 1867. Because they were prepared to be in places where they were deprived of Mass on weekdays and often Sundays as well, the Sisters became 'Church' for the locals.

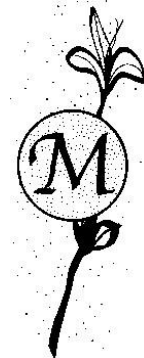
