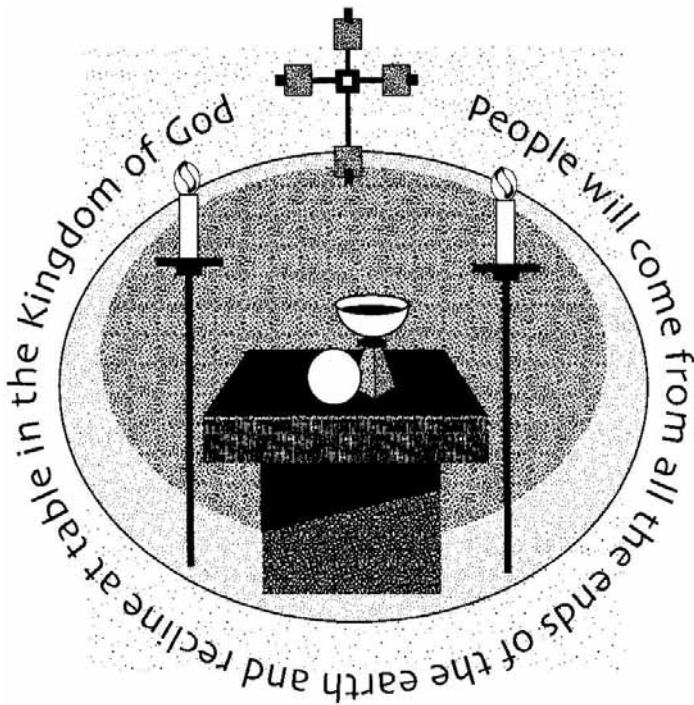

Give your people joy, Lord!

Introduction: In progressing with St Luke's Gospel, we continue the journey of Jesus towards Jerusalem. Once again we hear difficult words about the obstacles that can prevent a true response in faith in being Christ's disciples.



FIRST READING: Isaiah 66:18-21

We hear a text from Isaiah that is used to go with the Gospel passage. In both passages God's plan is meant to be for all peoples, but not everyone is prepared to listen

Response: Psalm 117

Go out to all the world and tell the Good News

SECOND READING: Hebrews 12:5-7, 11-13

We hear an extended metaphor of what it is to be the children of God. Even a loving father knows at times that punishment is part of the good training.

Gospel Acclamation:

Sung Alleluia

GOSPEL READING: Luke 13:22-30

We hear that at the time of Jesus his preaching was not directed only to the Jews, but was to be opened up for all to take their places at the feast in the kingdom of God.

MIGRANT AND REFUGEE WEEK: 23RD – 29TH AUGUST "I WAS A STRANGER UNTIL YOU WELCOMED ME"

The Australian Human Rights Commission has used World Refugee Day to remind Australians of the ongoing need for asylum seekers to be treated humanely. Commission President Catherine Branson QC, said World Refugee Day, which marks the beginning of Refugee Week, should cause us to reflect on the harsh reality that millions of people around the world flee their homes every year to escape persecution.

"The annual figures released just last week by the UN refugee agency show that more than 43 million people were forcibly displaced worldwide at the end of 2009, the highest number of people uprooted by conflict and persecution in the last 15 years."

"Australia has a long history of providing help and a safe haven to refugees from around the world and helping them to build new lives free from fear of violence and trauma,"

"That history has led to our community being greatly enriched over the years by the many contributions made to Australian life by individuals and communities that have come to this country seeking refuge." Ms Branson said it was right for Australia to continue to provide support to refugees and to continue to honour its international obligations with respect to those seeking asylum.

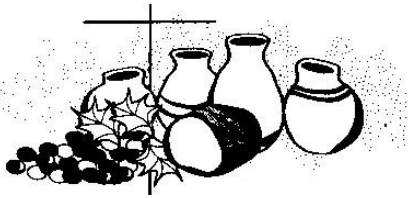

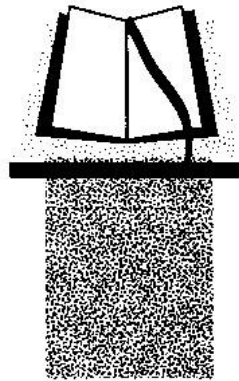
