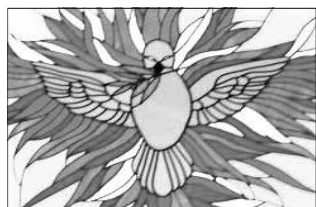

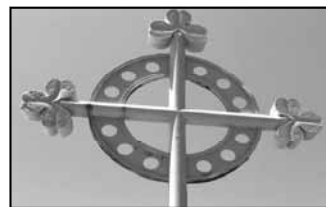

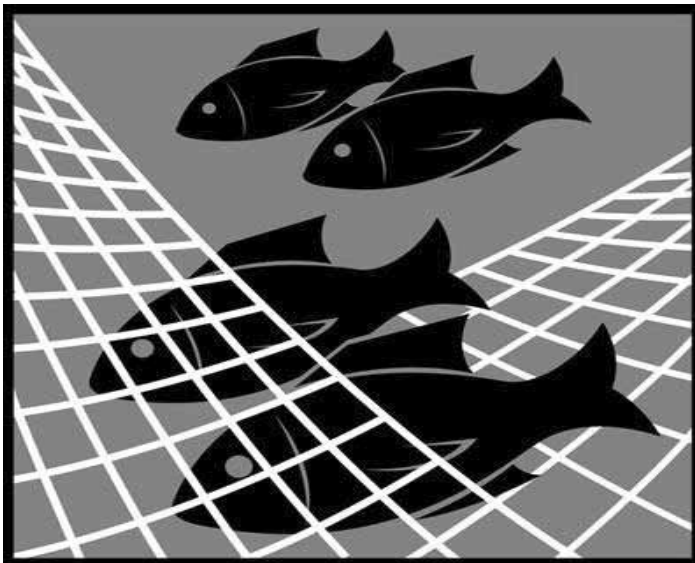

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ

Re: Diocesan Pastoral Council

Since our assembly in 2018, I have commissioned 9 task groups to report to me regarding the propositions of the Assembly.

These task groups are:

- Co-responsibility of the Mission
- Technology & Communications
- Mission to those on the Edge
- Governance Structures & Roles
- Governance & Leadership Formation
- Evangelisation
- Faith Education
- Youth
- Multicultural Youth

I have received to date reports from nearly all these task groups and I would propose this would be the basis for the discussion at a Diocesan Pastoral Council. Over these past 3 years I visited each of your parish communities and listened to the Pastoral and Finance Councils. Regionally, I have listened to the various gatherings in the Northern, Southern, Central, Central Highlands and Central West parts of the Diocese. From each of these areas I am happy to say a Regional Pastoral Council has been formed in 4 out of 5 of these regions.

The Regional Pastoral Councils have now assumed a leadership structure within the region and under a chair have been meeting regularly. I am hopeful that the fifth region will soon have a Regional Pastoral Council in place.

As I look into 2020, it is my wish that the Diocesan Pastoral Council be formed. In doing so I now call for nominations from each of the Regional Pastoral Councils. There will be two (2) representatives from each region:

- one member would be a member of the Regional Pastoral Council;
- the second member would be nominated by the Regional Pastoral Council and would be a representative of the whole region.

I would ask that these people could commit themselves to a two-year membership on the Diocesan Pastoral Council.

I look forward to receiving your nominations by COB 30 January 2020 on the included form, and after this date I will send out an invitation for these representatives.

Our first meeting of the Diocesan Pastoral Council will be on Saturday 21 March 2020. The meetings will be here in Rockhampton on a Saturday morning and I look forward to meeting with you.
