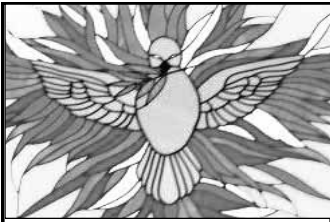

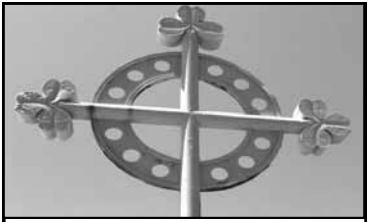

## SACRAMENTAL PROGRAM 2020 RECONCILIATION

Requirements are as follows: A Parent/Child Preparation session & 3 masses are to be attended with children. These sessions will begin at the times listed below:

**Enrolment Mass** Saturday March 7 5:40pm registration

2 additional masses (dates of own choice – attend by May 9) \*\* evidence of attendance to be recorded on Sacramental card in order to be eligible to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation and Eucharist.

You are required to celebrate your first Reconciliation on any Saturday afternoon at 5:00 pm at Sacred Heart Church after March 7 and prior to May 9.

## CONFIRMATION & EUCHARIST

Preparation for the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist will follow Reconciliation. Your child must have received the Sacrament of Reconciliation & attended the enrolment mass and 2 additional masses before being eligible for Confirmation and Eucharist.

The dates for Confirmation and Eucharist preparation sessions are as follows:

**Confirmation Information Session** Saturday May 9 3:45pm registration

**Confirmation Enrolment Mass** Saturday May 16 5:40pm registration

2 additional masses (dates of own choice – attend by July 18) \*\* evidence of attendance to be recorded on Sacramental Card

**Eucharist Information Session** Saturday July 18 3:45pm registration

**Eucharist Enrolment Mass** Saturday July 25 5:40pm registration

2 additional masses (dates of own choice – attend by August 14) \*\* evidence of attendance to be recorded on Sacramental Card.

## ST VINCENT DE PAUL

The last 3 months has been very busy for St Vincent de Paul in Yeppoon. Thank you all for your kind donations & support which has helped to support 84 families over Christmas with hampers costing in excess of \$10,000 on the coast. We also helped 35 children with our back to school education funds with us supplying, school books & uniforms, costing \$ 10,500. The families affected by fires are still suffering & in need of our ongoing support. We have helped 31 families with clothing, food, furniture & financial assistance from our local funds as well as the state disaster fund in excess of \$120,000 in cash given to the families in our community so far. The last fortnight alone we have helped 12 new families, as part of our long term commitment. With this our support office is operating 3 afternoons a week to help those in need. # Be Opened

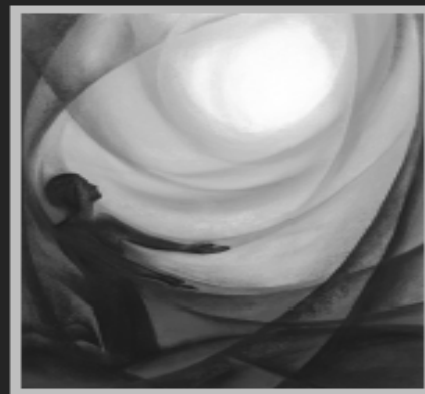
*A journey to new life*
