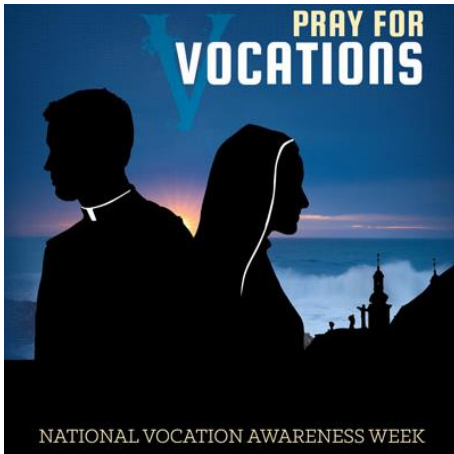

Good morning from my home to yours. Peace be with you.

This weekend we hear the Gospel of Jesus calming the stormy seas where the disciples were in the boat and they were afraid when Jesus approached them. Jesus then calls Peter out onto the water to walk with him, he did for a moment but became afraid when he saw the winds and the waves crashing upon him.

This is also National Vocations Awareness Week, looking and celebrating people's vocation to: marriage, single life, religious life and ordained ministry. This week the Priests of the Rockhampton Diocese gathered in Emu Park at 'The Haven'. It's been a very special time and a very sacred time where we share and reflect upon that ministry that we share with you in very special ways.

I remember my own ordination in 2004 and reflect upon the gathering of family and friends and the wider community of the Diocese. Thank you for the faith that you share and continue to share with and within your own families. We pray that God continue to guide us all as we journey and share the vocation that God calls each of us to.

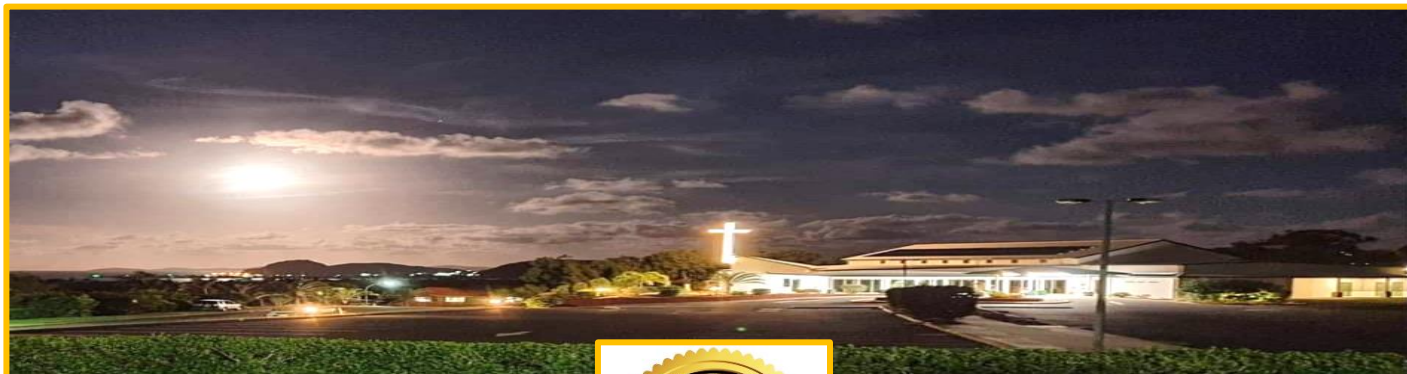
